## HATS REGULATIONS

## To be signed by both student and parent upon registration. **Registration will not be accepted until form is signed.**

The following guidelines have been instituted for all HATS classes in an effort to help classes run smoothly and to be profitable for all students:

-Students will complete and turn in homework assignments on time.

-There is to be absolutely no gum, food, or drink inside the church except in the lunch room and Talk Room.

- Students will be on time for class. On the rare occasion the student arrives late for class, the student will enter the class quietly so as to minimize class disruption.
- -The student is responsible for contacting the teacher and getting missed homework assignments. These assignments will be ready to turn in when the student returns to the following class.

-Siblings are not permitted in the classroom. Only the student taking the course and the parent are welcome in the classroom.

-The library (Study Room) is reserved for quiet study. The Talk Room is provided for quiet conversations.

-The student will be in the Study Room or Talk Room when not in class. It is understood that the student must stay in one of these areas when not in class.

-In the event that a student who is not accompanied by his parent must leave and then return to HATS, a parent-signed note of permission must be given to the person in charge at the HATS desk. This applies to student drivers and their passengers.

-HATS has a "No PDA" (Public Displays of Affection) (of a "romantic" nature) policy. All students are expected to cheerfully comply.

-Name tags must be worn in the building and returned to the student's folder when leaving the building.

-Students and parents agree to have a cooperative spirit.

-Due to church policy, parent monitors are required to be present during classes. Upon registering for HATS, the parent must commit to serve as a monitor three times for the first class and two times for each additional class. If a student registers for two classes, the parent must monitor five times, seven times for three classes, etc., up to a maximum of nine times. Monitor assignments are posted on the HATS web site <u>hatsonline.wordpress.com</u>. If a monitor assignment is missed, a postcard will be sent to the parent. This counts toward the four postcards. (Explanation below)

-Parents: a "postcard" will be sent by email each time that your student violates any of the regulations. If four postcards are received, your child will be dropped from HATS classes and no refund will be made.

-The leaders of Hempfield Homeschoolers and HATS reserve the right to send a postcard to a parent for any unacceptable behavior by the student or parent not covered by the above regulations.

DRESS CODE: Students will wear modest clothing reflecting Christ and showing respect toward other students and teachers. -Shirts must have sleeves.

-Shirts and pants must meet when standing or sitting. No midriff-style shirts.

-Clothing which advertises or promotes alcoholic beverages or cigarettes will not be worn.

-Shorts or skirts will be no shorter than three inches above the knee.

-Facial jewelry, other than earrings (worn in the ears), is not permitted.

- All undergarments must be completely covered by the student's clothing.

-Students MUST have their cell phones turned off during classes.

**Refund policy**: If a student desires to withdraw, a refund minus \$35 per class will be given if **1]** the class is full (at least 12 students) and **2]** a replacement student can be added to the class from the waiting list. No changes after the second class session. The family registration fee is non-refundable.

In signing this form, the parent also attests that he/she has read the HATS refund policy (brochure p. 2 and above) and that his or her student is not enrolled in a public charter school.
